A BILL

To amend the 21st Century Cures Act to improve the administration, oversight, and impact of opioid use disorder grants, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Clarity for Opioid-Use
- 5 Reduction and Expenditures Act" or the "CURE Act".

1	SEC. 2. IMPROVING ADMINISTRATION, OVERSIGHT, AND IM-
2	PACT OF OPIOID USE DISORDER GRANTS.
3	(a) Accountability and Oversight.—Subsection
4	(c) of section 1003 of the 21st Century Cures Act (42
5	U.S.C. 290ee–3a) is amended to read as follows:
6	"(c) Accountability and Oversight.—
7	"(1) Standardized system for data col-
8	LECTION.—The Secretary shall develop and imple-
9	ment a standardized system for collecting data from
10	States receiving grants under subsection (b).
11	"(2) Submission of data.—A State receiving
12	a grant under subsection (b) shall submit to the Sec-
13	retary, through the standardized system referred to
14	in paragraph (1), on a quarterly basis, a description
15	of—
16	"(A) the purposes for which the grant
17	funds received by the State under such sub-
18	section for the preceding fiscal year were ex-
19	pended and a description of the activities of the
20	State under the grant;
21	"(B) the ultimate recipients of amounts
22	provided to the State, including the name, loca-
23	tion, and taxpayer identification number of any
24	grant subrecipients;
25	"(C) the number of individuals served
26	through the grant; and

1	"(D) such other information as determined
2	appropriate by the Secretary.
3	"(3) Use of other federal grant-track-
4	ING SYSTEMS.—The Secretary shall, in collecting
5	data through the standardized system referred to in
6	paragraph (1), to the extent feasible, make use of
7	other Federal grant-tracking systems to avoid dupli-
8	cation of efforts.".
9	(b) Report to Congress.—Section 1003(f) of the
10	21st Century Cures Act (42 U.S.C. 290ee–3a(f)) is
11	amended—
12	(1) by amending paragraph (2) to read as fol-

14	"(2) the activities of the recipients and sub-
15	recipients of the grants; and"; and
16	(2) by amending paragraph (3) to read as fol-

18	"(3) each entity that receives a grant or is a
19	subrecipient of a grant under this section, including
20	the funding level provided to such recipient or sub-
21	recipient.".
22	(c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
23	sections (a) and (b) shall apply beginning 180 days after
