Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Davidson County Business Park Utility Extension Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 28 W Center Street, Lexington, NC 27292. The funding would be used for the extension of sanitary sewer infrastructure that will involve the construction of a new sewer pump station, wet well, and other associated equipment for 7,700 linear feet of 8" force main and 3,883 linear feet of gravity sewer lines to be laid. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it involves the laying of new sewer mains and the installation of a pump station. The EPA's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) may be used to support municipal projects that include sewer system upgrades and installation/construction of new pipes, pump stations, and force mains.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
